### FACILITIES

The land is hilly but not difficult to walk. There will be a Port-a-john. **BRING YOUR OWN LAWN CHAIRS** (without skinny tip feet as they might skin into the soft soil) to sit under the trees.

### PARKING

We will park in the field at the end of Spring House Lane. If the land is soggy we will park along the edge of Old State Road and Spring House Lane. There will be signs to guide you. We hope a few folks will participate in the clean-up at the end of lunch.

## **LOCATION AND DIRECTIONS**

**NOTE:** Construction on the Turnpike has shut off direct access from the south on Old State Road. You have to proceed around the obstruction using these directions. Google directions may take you the wrong way.

### **DIRECTIONS FROM ROUTE 8**

From the turnpike interchange, proceed about three miles North on route 8 and turn right at the red belt sign. At the bottom of the hill, turn left to follow the red belt, which is Bakerstown Road. Travel 3.3 miles and turn left on Old State Road, just past a Catholic church (Ignore the detour signs). Travel 0.8 miles and turn left onto Spring House Lane.

### **DIRECTIONS FROM ROUTE 19 (PERRY HIGHWAY)**

From the Perry Highway exit of 279 (Park and ride lot), travel North on Perry highway/route 19 to Three Degree Road. Turn right at the light at Three Degree Road. At the second light, turn left onto McKnight Road, then the next right onto Babcock Blvd. Continue on Babcock Blvd. and turn right at the Red belt sign, which is Bakerstown Road. Travel 0.5 miles and turn right on Old State Road (Ignore the detour signs). Travel 0.8 miles and turn left onto Spring House Lane.
